

registration | Registrations are on a firstcome first-serve basis. Pre-registration paid in full is required for class participation. Adult classes are open to everyone age 18 and older.

confirmations | Once registration is completed, participants will only be notified if a class is cancelled or changed. If you are not notified in advance, it means the class will be held as scheduled.

waiting list | When a class reaches capacity, participants will be placed on a waiting list. People on the waiting list will be contacted in the order of the waiting list if space becomes available.

refunds | FULL refunds will be made if the class is cancelled by Community Education. Community Education is a self-supporting program, so classes cannot be run at a deficit. Therefore, ALL refunds must be requested at least 3 days before the start of a class. Unfortunately, refunds cannot be given after this 3-day time frame. A \$4 processing fee will be charged for dropped classes. Non-credit card refunds will be paid by check within 21 days.






